

Global Grant 2686485 Saving Mothers & Children in Uganda



Mothers and children traveled to meet us to share their needs, 2024

Global Grant 2686485 will provide diagnostic tools to help identify high risk pregnancies and infant care management equipment to reduce the high incidence of congenital defects in southwestern Uganda. Pregnant women unable to pay for transportation to the hospital hours away are reduced to giving birth at home or on the road. They are unable to dream of healthy full term babies due to access and medical planning. A birth to a child with skeletal or cognitive disability significantly impacts the wellbeing of the mother and family.

Our goal is to provide the medical professionals with data to identify high risk pregnancies, training and education of medical professionals and the families themselves, and ultimately, to enable these women and families to lead healthy and productive lives. We will also provide seeding for economic development within some pilot communities to grow self-sustaining members and the potential to expand to other communities.

The funding budget is \$195,000. We have raised \$95,000 and need an additional \$100,000 to achieve our goal of submitting by Feb 2026!
