1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Our Rotary club partners with a non-profit organization called Foster Love located in Brea, CA. We purchase sweet case kits and bicycle parts from Foster Love and then get together to decorate and fill the sweet cases and build the bicycles. We then give the finished products back to Foster Love who distributes them to local Orange County kids living in foster care. The Sweet Cases are sturdy black duffel bags and are filled with a blanket, stuffed animal, hygiene kits, and art supplies and are meant to replace the county issued black trash bags given to kids when they move between one foster home to another. The bikes vary in size for all age groups and serve as a chance to get outside and play or for older kids provide transportation to and from school or work. This project activities took place in the gym at the Boys and Girls club of La Habra in February.

Seven Rotarians participated.

Assemble bikes and decorate/ fill all of the sweet cases/duffle bags

We put together 52 Sweet cases and assembled 15 bikes and had approximately 20 additional teenage helpers participated from the Keystone and Interact club.

To give foster children needed supplies while moving and bicycles for fun and transportation.

Keystone and Interact club participated and assisted with bike assembly and filling/decorating the sweet cases.
