The project entails rebuilding a baseball diamond at Rotary Park. The club is partnering with the lowa Park Parks Department to carry out the project. The city has faced delays in some of its work due to weather and other obligations. The club purchased new bases, a home plate, and a pitcher's mound for the field. In addition, the club financed the repair of the backstop and the construction of a concrete base for the backstop, as mandated by the city. The club contributed \$331.02 to the City of Iowa Park to help with the cost of the concrete curve, which the city paid to Jesus Valdez Concrete for that portion of the project. The club paid the remaining cost directly. The work occurred in March, April, and May. The project is not finished as of this date.
