3. Briefly describe your project (who did what, when and where did project activities take place?) in 100 words or less. The Rotary Club of Nampa partnered with the Boys & Girls Club of Canyon County to create a new teen center provides a safe gathering place for mentoring, homework assistance and leadership opportunities for about 100 youth annually in South Nampa. The new center is an accessible hub with computers, games, crafts, food preparation items and teen-friendly décor and signage. A grand opening celebration was held Dec. 12, 2025. Attendees 18 included Nampa Mayor Debbie Kling, national and local leaders from the Boys & Girls Club, members of the Nampa Rotary Club and about 50 excited kids. The club is currently working with Boys & Girls Club of Canyon County leadership and participants launch of a new Interact club. KIVI, a local television station, ran a [news story](#) about the new teen center. On Feb. 6, 2026 the Boys & Girls Club hosted the first teen night event in the newly renovated space.
4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there? The newly refurbished teen center is projected to serve 100 youth annually with mentoring, homework assistance and a safe, fun environment for socializing.
5. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Rotarians and family members. Briefly tell what did? Rotarians and their family members spent two work days assembling tables and painting two large classrooms for the new two-room teen center. The project leader met twice on site with the coordinator to facilitate the work days and purchase equipment for the teen center.
6. If a cooperating organization(s) other than the beneficiary was involved, what was its role? The BGCCC received a matching \$35,000 grant from Panda Cares, a philanthropic partner of Boys & Girls Club of America. This project was the only grant awarded in 2025. Panda Care funds were used to purchase tables, chairs and computers. The grant also paid for paint and supplies for the Rotary volunteers.
