1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

For the past 7 years the Rotary Club of Long Beach has filled 1500 string bags with food and hygiene items for the pantry locations at LBCC and CSULB annually. The Pantry locations at each school provide food and other resources for students in need. In these past 7 years the need for our students has increased dramatically and we hope to increase our donated number of bags and other items to continue to support them. Dates and locations for the events:

- August 6, 2025 at Long Beach City College
- January 14, 2026 at California State University, Long Beach

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Two event locations (one for each school) = 120 total Rotary members

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? We always estimate the students benefiting from our project as the number of bags we distribute = 1500. However, many of the items can be shared by family members and friends. In addition, we were able to fill the pantry shelves with 300 hygiene items that didn't fit in the string bags (laundry detergent, feminine hygiene products).

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? We hope that the long term impact includes students who are able to continue their studies with their food need lessened and a longer success of completed education for better employment opportunities.
